The regular meeting of the East Nottingham Township Board of Supervisors was held in the Township building on May 10, 2004. Those present were: Chairman, Samuel A. Chairman, Samuel A. Goodley, Jr., called the meeting to order at 7:05pm.

Meeting commenced with Vice-Chairman, Thomas J. Olivieri leading the Pledge of Allegiance.

Treasurer's Report

Bills for Approval: Mrs. Mason presented the treasurer's report stating that East Nottingham's total cash assets amount to \$2,273,918.14. Bills totaling \$64,094.08 were presented for approval for payment from General Fund. Income received for April 2004 totaled \$98,393.76 realized from taxes, escrow, court fines, franchise fees, permits, endowment fees, fire hydrant reimbursements and miscellaneous permit fees. **On motion by Chairman Goodley, seconded by Vice-Chairman Olivieri, it was unanimously approved to pay all the bills from the General Funds for a total of \$87,249.98.**

Zoning Officer's Report (ZO) - Mrs. Kovach, Township ZO, reported a total of 39 building permits issued during the month of April as compared to 36 in March. This included 37 certificates of occupancy, eight (8) sheds and one (1) demolition permit for costs totaling \$19,572 with construction costs amounting to \$2,369,020.

FOR INFORMATION ONLY (FIO): Mrs. Kovach reported Tommy Tinkers have received their building permit and will commence construction in the near future. Also, Mr. William Headley has recently submitted a building permit application with plans and sewage design and will be providing remaining documentation shortly. Target date for grand opening of Happy Harry's is tentatively late June/early July. Domino's Pizza has also been issued their permit as they will have retail space at the Happy Harry site. Also FIO, the task of codifying the ENT ordinances continues as three (3) publishers have submitted their proposals. This project will be addressed shortly for review with concerned parties.

Roadmaster Report: The April Roadmaster Report was submitted and accepted as presented with no outstanding issues.

Public Presentation: Mr. Bill Stullken, representative of Southeastern Chester County Refuse Authority (SECCRA), spoke to the BOS and residents of ENT concerning the proposed expansion of SECCRA while requesting endorsement from ENT in the form of a submitted resolution, "**The Need for Solid Waste Disposal Capacity**", in support of future expansion of SECCRA. The same request of all 24 surrounding municipalities serviced by SECCRA is being made in favor of SECCRA's future growth. With additional explanation, a question/answer period and the reading of proposed resolution, a **motion was then entered** by Chairman Goodley, seconded by Vice-Chairman Olivieri, and **unanimously approved** adoption of the prepared resolution submitted in support of SECCRA's continuing growth.

Bid Openings:

A. Grader Bid - A single bid was received for the grader, however upon review invoice was not found. A motion was then entered by Chairman Goodley, seconded by Supervisor Shelton, tabling bid to May 17th Work Session allowing time to contact the bidder to complete bid package, and was unanimously approved.

B. Material/Equipment – Five companies submitted bids to ENT for materials and equipment. The bids were submitted by D. M. Stoltzfus & Son, Inc., (materials only); Compass Quarries; d/b/a Independence Construction Materials (ICM) (materials only); AI-Maryland LP (d/b/a ICM) (materials only) Long's Asphalt, Inc., (equipment only) and McMinn's Asphalt Co., Inc., (materials only). Bids were read and awarded as follows with motions entered accordingly.

On motion by Supervisor Shelton, seconded by Vice-Chairman Olivieri, it was unanimously approved to award the **bid for stone** to D. M. Stoltzfus & Son, Inc. in the amount of \$59,155.00.

C. Road Projects – Five bid packages were distributed for the road projects with return of only one submitted bid. However upon review and discussion by the BOS it was agreed to award the Woods Road Project (Fifth Street to Rt 472) to Melchiorre Construction Co. and suspended remaining two projects until future date yet to be determined. Motion was then entered by Chairman Goodley, seconded by Vice-Chairman Olivieri, and unanimously approved awarding the Woods Road project in the amount of \$136,683 to Melchiorre Construction Co.

A. Joel Brown: Re: Open Space Referendum (OSR) – Mr. Brown discussed the possibility of holding a hearing relating to the Open Space Referendum encouraging the BOS to place this issue on the November ballot while expressing his concerns.

B. Mr. Joe Bauer, Oxford Area Recreation Authority (OARA) representative, updated the BOS and residents of the status and progress currently underway with the OARA. Mr. Bauer also reported that a survey has been developed inquiring as to what specific facilities the community is most interested in having and is available from the Township Secretary.

New Items of Business:

A. Escrow Releases – On motion by Chairman Goodley, seconded by Vice-Chairman Olivieri the following escrows were unanimously approved for release; **Happy Harry's**, Release #08, for \$72,268.26; **Misty Meadows**, Release #14, for \$28,350.44; **Blackburn Knoll**, Release #12, for \$7,317.50; **Darlington Hunt IV**, Release #28, for \$186.26; **Pennwood Subdivision**, Release #05, for \$105.00; and **Oxford Area High School**, Release #12, for \$75.63.






