

**SPECIAL HEARING
EAST NOTTINGHAM TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENTS
HORSES AND
EROSION & SEDIMENT CONTROL PERMITS
JUNE 13, 2005**

A public hearing was held by the Board of Supervisors on Monday, June 13, 2005 at 6:30 P.M. at the Township Building located at 158 Election Road, East Nottingham, Oxford, Pennsylvania. The purpose of the hearing was to receive public comment on the proposed amendments to the East Nottingham Township Zoning Ordinance.

Present were Chairman Thomas J. Olivieri, Vice-Chairman Samuel A. Goodley Jr., Supervisor Charles D. Shelton, Township Manager Eugene Boneker, Secretary Pat Brady and approximately 7 members of the public.

Chairman Olivieri opened the meeting at 6:30 P.M.. Township Manager, Eugene Boneker moderated the hearing from that point on. He announced the hearing was to receive public comment on the proposed amendments to the East Nottingham Township Zoning Ordinance. He provided for the record, a Proof of Publication of the advertising of the hearing on May 24, 2005 and May 31, 2005 in the Daily Local News. Township Manager, Eugene Boneker proceeded to read the proposed Amendments to East Nottingham Township Zoning Ordinance in its entirety.

The hearing was then opened to the public for comments or questions.

Alvin Miller- Why is this being done? Stated that it's only for the Amish and that shouldn't be allowed. It allows the Amish not to pay their back taxes for the Act 319 Law. We have to pay their taxes and that's not fair. He's putting money in his pocket.


Ken Knapp- Asked if Erosion and Sediment Control was studied comprehensively for the entire township.

Chairman Olivieri stated that the Board of Supervisors will be considering these amendments for adoption at the Regular Meeting to follow at 7:00 P.M..


Motion made by Chairman Olivieri to adjourn the meeting at 6:40P.M..




