

**MINUTES
EAST NOTTINGHAM TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
PUBLIC HEARING
HISTORIC ORDINANCE
NOVEMBER 19, 2007**

The Public Hearing of the East Nottingham Township Board of Supervisors was held in the Township Building on November 19, 2007. Those present were: Vice-Chairman Michael P. Miller, Supervisor Percy Reynolds, Supervisor Charles D. Shelton. Chairman Leo M. Levandowski and Supervisor Gene Turns were unable to attend.

The Public Hearing was called to order at 8:30 P.M. by Vice-Chairman Miller.

Vice-Chairman Miller read the proof of publication, which was published in the Daily Local News on November 5th & November 12th, 2007. Vice-Chairman Miller handed the Hearing over to our Solicitor Alan Novak.

Solicitor Alan Novak stated this is the second Public Hearing. We had submitted an Ordinance to the Chester County Planning Commission and received a review letter from the County. The recommendations from the County were incorporated into the Ordinance for the Public Hearing tonight.

Public Comment-

Vice-Chairman Miller asked Solicitor Novak to go to section 2506C. The first line should read conditional use in lieu of additional use. Solicitor Novak agreed and will have this corrected.

Vice-Chairman Miller stated he feels that all notices to residents should be sent out Certified Mail and kept on record.

Vice-Chairman Miller asked the Chairman of the Historic Commission Ralph Denlinger, if there was any place in the Township that has all the records and Historical Resources. Ralph Denlinger replied in the meeting room there are cabinets that hold this information.

Vice-Chairman Miller questioned under the section Violations & Penalties where does that fee of \$500.00 a day go?. Solicitor Novak responded, the General Fund and is used at the discretion of the Board.

Solicitor Novak stated the Planning Commission and the Historic Commission were very involved in the process.

Adjournment- Motion made by Supervisor Shelton seconded by Supervisor Reynolds to adjourn the meeting at 8:52 P.M..


