

**MINUTES
EAST NOTTINGHAM TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
PUBLIC HEARING
NOVEMBER 15, 2010**

Pursuant to public notice, the East Nottingham Township Board of Supervisors held a public hearing in the Township Building on November 15, 2010. Those present were: Chairman Leo M. Levandowski, Supervisor Gene Turns, Supervisor John P. Coldiron, Zoning Officer PJ Scheese, Solicitor Winifred Sebastian, Solicitor Gene Twardowski, and guests.

The hearing was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Chairman Leo M. Levandowski, who then turned it over the Solicitor Winifred Sebastian.

Ms. Sebastian stated that the hearing was advertised in the Friday, October 22, 2010 edition of the *Daily Local News*.

Ms. Sebastian stated that hearing was about an Ordinance Amending Chapter 24 of the East Nottingham Township Code Titled Taxation Special Part 1 Earned Income Tax to Levy a Tax on Earned Income and New Profits; Providing Exemptions; Requiring Tax Returns; Requiring Employers to Withhold and Remit Tax; and Related Provisions. Ms. Sebastian also stated that this does not change anything but to reflect new law. In 2012 the tax will be collected by a new tax collector. The revenue generated is estimated to be \$1,400,000 in the year 2011. There are no exemptions from this tax.


Ms. Sebastian then opened up the floor for questions. There were none.

A motion was made by John P. Coldiron, seconded by Gene Turns to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried.




