The Regular Meeting of the Board of Supervisors of East Nottingham Township was held in the Township Building on August 8, 2011. Those present were: Chairman Leo M. Levandowski, Vice-Chairman Percy Reynolds, Supervisor Gene Turns, Supervisor John P. Coldiron, Supervisor Ed Lobley, Secretary Pat Brady, Treasurer Suzanne Hamlin , Zoning Officer P.J. Scheese and guests.

The Meeting was called to order at 7:05 P.M..

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Vice-Chairman Reynolds.

Minutes For Review- Chairman Levandowski stated there are copies of the Minutes for review on the table for the following:

Treasurer's Report- Suzie Hamlin reported East Nottingham's cash assets amount to \$2,835,572.26. Income received from July totals \$81,679.17 realized from taxes, escrow, court fines, permits, inspection fees, fire hydrant reimbursement and miscellaneous fees. General Fund balance as of 7/31/2011 is \$222,017.93. Suzie requested to add 2 new bills one to Pa One Call in the amount of \$46.08 and one for Toshiba for \$203.00 making a new total for General Fund of \$20,071.67.

Suzie discussed with the Board there was a state increase for mileage to \$.55.5 which Suzie has requested that the Board, if acceptable, make a motion increasing the rate.

Oxford Area Sewer Authority Report- Vice-Chairman Reynolds stated they went to settlement last Thursday on the USDA Loan. The 537 Plan was sent to DEP and they have until 9/15 to make their decision.

The Board advised they are not, due to the economy, in a position to purchase and move the house at this time.
