* John Latschar, Glatfelter Pulp Timber Company- spoke to the Board regarding his suggestion for the Board to consider waiving several sections of the Forestry & Logging Standards (27-406) of the Zoning Ordinance. In his opinion, these sections of the ordinance would prohibit the farmer, Ben Lapp, from achieving his goal of turning the area, approximately 5 acres of woodland on the farm located at 556 Mt. Pleasant Road in East Nottingham Township into cropland.

Motion made by Supervisor Lobley seconded by Supervisor Coldiron to inform Mr. Latschar that the Zoning Ordinance, specifically sections (27-406) does not apply to moving timber . Further, the Township will look to the Conservation District for guidance concerning a Forestry Ordinance.
