Solicitor Eugene Twardowski stated the purpose of the hearing was to consider the adoption of an Ordinance amending the Township of East Nottingham Zoning Ordinance of 1971 which would terminate the Transferable Development Rights Program.


Solicitor Twardowski asked if there were any comments or questions from the Board of Supervisors. No questions were asked and no comments were received.

Upon motion made by Supervisor Reynolds and seconded by Supervisor Coldiron, the hearing was adjourned at approximately 7:15 p.m.






