The regular meeting of the East Nottingham Township Planning Commission was held in the Township Building on May 27, 2008 at 7:00 pm. Those present were: Chairperson, Joseph R. Bauer, Jr., Planning Commission Members, Gene Turns, Walt Leis, John Wallace, Janice Gavin, Shannon Wells and Planning Commission Secretary, PJ Scheese. Vice-Chairperson, Clifford Lee was absent

Chairperson, Joseph R. Bauer, Jr., called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m.

Chairperson, Joseph R. Bauer, Jr. led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Ordinances

On-Lot Sewage Disposal Systems

Chairman Joe Bauer told the PC that Lower Oxford added into the definition of "Sewage" in the second line between "human beings" and "or any noxious" the words "or kennel." The PC decided to change that to "or kennel animals."

Then the word "Kennel" was added to the definitions between "Board" and "Lot." It should read: "Kennel" – as defined in the East Nottingham Township Zoning Ordinance."

In Section 5. Maintenance under number 3:

District 1 – the year is to be changed from "2009" to "2010."

District 2 – the year is to be changed from "2010" to "2011."

District 3 – the year is to be changed from "2011" to "2012."

In Section 5. Maintenance under number 4, second line the year is to be changed from "2009" to "2010."

John Wallace asked what each District was. Joe Bauer stated the following:

District 1 is everything north of Route 472.

District 2 is everything between Barnsley Road and Route 472.

District 3 is everything west of Barnsley Road.

There was some discussion about a Sewage Enforcement Administrator being established for the Township. The general thought is one person should be able to manage the entire Oxford Area. Shannon Wells asked about the cost of setting this system up and maintaining it. The cost could not be

calculated at this time, but the general thought is that it will take some time and money to set it up, but then it should not be that big of a deal to manage.

A Motion was made by Walt Leis, seconded by John Wallace, to pass this Ordinance on to the Board of Supervisors for approval, subject to the corrections suggested above, as well as the suggestion that fees should be discussed. The motion passed.


