A special meeting of the East Nottingham Township Planning Commission was held in the Township Building November 30, 2016. Those present were: Chairman John Wallace, Vice-Chair Janice Gavin, Members, Robert Stewart, Tom Faux, Joe Herlihy, Marc Arot and Planning Commission Secretary, PJ Scheese.

Chairman John Wallace asked PJ Scheese to explain what going into the Ag Security program means. PJ stated that properties that are part of this program are protected from nuisance lawsuits against farming activities and the issues that may arise from neighboring properties. She also explained that properties requesting be part of the open space program must first go into the Ag Security program. Then she showed the locations of these two properties on the zoning map, explaining that the owners of these two properties wish to enter the County Challenge Grant program and that the funds to cover the township's portion are already available in the open space funds currently existing. Sam Goodley added that the Ag Security program also makes it harder for these properties to be condemned.

After some discussion a motion was made by Robert Stewart, seconded by Joe Herlihy, to recommend approval of these properties going into the Ag Security program to the Board of Supervisors. The motion carried.
